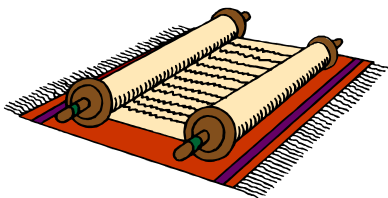

## Answers to Torah in the Round

### JULY

**July 3:** When there was no male heir, a daughter could inherit the property.

**July 10:** The word “matot” means tribes. The word “masei” means journeys.

**July 17:** Devarim is the name of the Parashot and it means “words.”

**July 24:** Moses was not permitted by G-d to enter Canaan and blamed the Israelites for their rebellious behavior.

**July 31:** The second word of the parashot is “ekev.” It means “if only” the Israelites would follow the commandments, blessings would follow not curses.

### AUGUST

**August 7:** Moses gave the Israelites the choice of blessings or curses.

**August 14:** A judge should be non-prejudicial and no one should get special consideration.

**August 21:** If a woman captive appeals to the Israelite, the captive should remove her captive garment, remain in the tent for one month to mourn her mother and father. If the captive is not appealing to the Israelite, he should let her go.

**August 28:** “Ki Tavo” means (when you come). All first fruits must go to the Temple to honor G-d.
